Two Arrhythmogenic Cardiomyopathy researchers (one basic scientist and one clinical scientist) with the most outstanding and pioneering recent contribution in this field, published or in-press, will be awarded the Research Prize. The prize consists of a sum of 30 000 Swiss Francs (15 000 Swiss Francs for the basic science research prize and 15 000 Swiss Francs for the clinical science research prize) and an invitation to the Zurich International Symposium on Arrhythmogenic Cardiomyopathies 2022, including travel and accommodation costs.
